Professor Alok Dhawan provided a brief update and deliberated the agenda points. All the members actively participated. The action points suggested by the EC are as follows:

- EC members approved the minutes of the meeting of AGM held on February 26, 2022.
- It was proposed to organise lectures on various topics such as implications of new labour court, how to earn money after retirement, nanotechnology in agriculture, taxation laws, conservation of water, wealth from agriculture waste, risk management, perfumery, floriculture.
- It was also proposed to organise events on industry academia interaction in next four-six months.
- It was decided to organise a mega event on **Holistic health and wellness** which would include naturopathy, homeopathy, Ayurveda, aromatherapy, Buddhist therapy etc. It was proposed to organise this symposium towards the end of October, 2022 (say 29-10-22). An organization committee may be formed urgently by the President and Rs five lacs sponsorship is also to be arranged. The venue may be Indian Industries Association, Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar. No delegate fee will be charged. The committee may include, Sri LK Jhunjhunwala, Dr Rakesh Kapoor and Dr JV Singh, IIA representative etc. Firms may have stalls at the venue
- A talk of Director, CSIR- Central Electronics Engineering Research Institute (CEERI), Pilani was also proposed on July 2 or 9, 2022.

- AKWL will continue to organize few webinars related to industry and academic interest
- It was also suggested that membership drive will be taken up along with upgradation of website as well as change in name.
